** Scenario-based: "Imagine if you were faced with..."*

** Value-fit: "In what kind of environment do you truly flourish?"*

Utilize the STAR format: * **Situation, Task, Action, Result Stay focused and brief. Concentrate on results.*

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3. ****The Filters****

* Applicant Tracking Systems * Pre-screen assessments * AI highlighting resume keywords before you engage with a human

Customize your resume and wording for every job opportunity.
Communicate in a way that resonates with them.

What Remains Unchanged

1. ****Your Narrative Holds Power****

Individuals are eager to discover:

* The purpose of your presence * Your relevant accomplishments * What inspires you

Create a compelling and assured narrative when asked, “Tell me about yourself.”
Concentrate on the journey that brought you to **this** position.

2. ****Being Here Matters****

True confidence doesn’t shout; it resonates quietly and powerfully. It’s a clear foundation.

Take a moment to calm your breath. Respond with purpose.
Demonstrate that you are a person who maintains composure in challenging situations and considers your words carefully before expressing them.

3. ****You’re Also Evaluating Them****

It’s a two-way street. You are evaluating:

* Do they appreciate your contributions?
* Do they practice what they preach?* Are you ready to unleash your full potential here?

Pose powerful inquiries: “What does achievement resemble in this position after six months?”
“What obstacles is your team facing right now?”
